Three, Presidential Scholarships \$12,000 each

Wallace State Community College – \$36,000

Three, Presidential Scholarships \$12,000 each

Jefferson State Community College – \$36,000

Three, Presidential Scholarships \$12,000 each

The University of Alabama – \$130,000

Three, Presidential Scholarships (22 ACT / 3.0 GPA)

Auburn University - \$120,000

Three, Full Tuition Scholarships \$40,000 each (Must be admitted to Auburn)

The University of West Alabama—\$100,000

Ten, \$2,500 per year for four years (19 ACT)

The University of Montevallo – \$78,000

One, \$4,500 per year (21 ACT), \$18,000

Five, \$3,000 per year (21 ACT), \$12,000 each

UAB – \$64,000

Four, \$4,000 per year/ \$16,000 each (24 ACT/2.5 GPA)

Huntingdon College—\$280,000

Five, \$14,000 per year

(no minimum GPA/ACT, providing YLDP students do not intend to participate in NCAA athletics)

Alabama State University—\$111,936

Three, Academic Incentive Scholarships- \$9,328 per year and up to \$500 in books for a max of eight semesters (must complete at least 24 credit hours per year and maintain at least a 3.0 GPA)

Troy University – \$50,000

One, Chancellor's Award 7,500 per year (25 ACT), \$30,000

Two, Excellence in Leadership Awards \$2,500 per year, \$10,000 each

(Cannot be stacked with Chancellors or Millennium Award)

Alabama A & M University - \$152,000

Four, Full Tuition Scholarships (21 ACT / 3.25 GPA)

YLDP Scholarship Awards

University of North Alabama – \$160,000

Twenty, \$2,000 per year

Can be stacked but not to exceed \$10,000/Year (18 ACT/3.0 GPA)

Auburn University Montgomery – \$78,000

Two, Chancellor's Awards \$4,000 per year

Two, \$3,000 onetime—2.5 GPA/17 ACT

Ten, Opportunity Scholarships \$1,000 per year (18 ACT or 950 SAT and 2.5 GPA)

Stillman College- \$60,000

Three, \$5,000 per year for four years (19 ACT/3.0 GPA)

The University of Iowa—\$100,000

Five, \$5,000 renewable for four years and stackable with other awards.

University of South Alabama – \$16,000

Two, \$2,000 per year Leadership Scholarships (24 ACT/3.0 GPA)

Jacksonville State University - \$15,000

May be divided among several students

Mississippi State University—\$12,000

Three, \$1,000 renewable scholarships for 4 years (22 ACT and 3.0 GPA)

Shelton State Community College – \$24,000

Two, Presidential Scholarships \$12,000 each

Bevill State Community College - \$24,000

Two, Presidential Scholarships \$12,000 each

Talladega College—\$4,000

(If higher GPA/ACT-can be considered for \$6,000-\$19,000)

Two, \$2,000 one time Freshman Leadership Scholarships (20 ACT/3.0 GPA)

This does stack with Recognition, Achievement, or Warhawk scholarship Total. Must be admitted by March 1st

Marion Military Institute

Three, 50% Tuition—Composite ACT of 19 or Higher / Unweighted Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or Higher

Monetary scholarships - \$20,000+
